

UC San Diego Division of Extended Studies medical insurance is required. In some cases, students can provide proof of their own insurance if it meets the following requirements:

- Plan must be Affordable Care Act (ACA) compliant
- At least \$500,000 per accident or illness, no annual or lifetime maximums
- At least \$25,000 repatriation of remains coverage
- At least \$100,000 medical evacuation coverage
- Maximum deductible of \$100 per person/per policy year in-network, \$200 per person/per policy year out-of-network
- Unlimited pre-existing condition coverage and mental health coverage, no appointment maximum
- Prescription copays not to exceed \$50
- \$6,350 per person/\$12,700 per family out-of-pocket maximum
- Maximum \$100 for ER copay, Maximum \$20 for Urgent Care or other visits
- Insurance company must be billed directly (cannot accept reimbursement-based plans)
- Insurance company must have an English-speaking claims representative based in the U.S.
- Insurance company must cover medical services for injury from participation in all types of recreational activities/sports.

How to apply for a medical insurance waiver

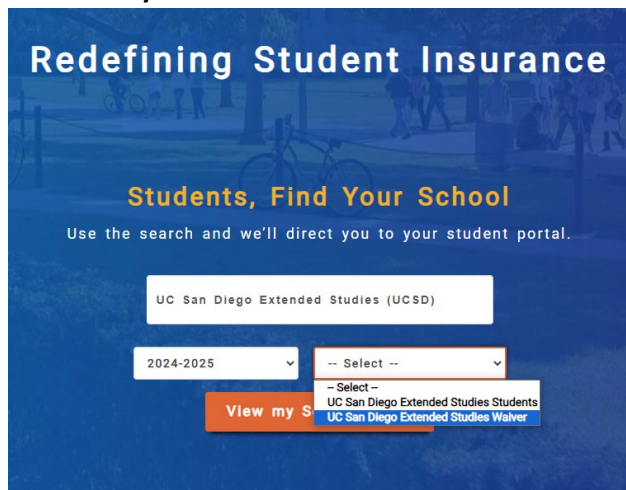
You can apply for a medical insurance waiver starting on the first day of the month before your program start date. For example, if your program begins on May 20, you can apply for a medical insurance waiver starting April 1. *Exception: September 2024 start dates can apply for a medical insurance waiver starting June 1, 2024.

If you need to apply for a medical insurance waiver outside of the application window stated above, please email DESHealthandSafety@ucsd.edu to ask about your options.

*Please note, applying for a medical insurance waiver does not guarantee approval of a waiver. Your plan must be reviewed to ensure it meets the minimum waiver requirements as listed above.

Please follow the steps below to apply for a medical insurance waiver:

1. Gather your medical insurance plan documents. You need to submit your full medical insurance plan summary in English. It must show your name, and dates of coverage.
2. Go to <https://jcbins.com/>
3. Complete the fields. School name: **UC San Diego Extended Studies (UCSD)**. Select plan year. Plan: **UC San Diego Extended Studies Waiver**. Click “View my School Portal”.



4. Review the medical insurance waiver requirements listed and make sure your plan meets all minimum requirements.
5. Click on “Submit Waiver Here”

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You must complete your waiver application in full, prior to the waiver deadline.

Once your waiver is approved, you will receive a waiver confirmation email.

You must meet eligibility and attendance requirements set by your school to purchase or waive this insurance coverage. The insurance company and/or Gallagher Insurance, Risk Management and Consulting (the "Company") maintains the right to investigate student (and dependent) status and attendance records to verify that the policy eligibility requirements have been met. If and whenever the Company discovers that the policy eligibility requirements have not been met, our only obligation is to refund premium payment, minus any claims paid. By enrolling in this plan you are agreeing to your insurance carrier's binding arbitration policies listed in the plan brochure. It is a crime to knowingly provide false, incomplete, or misleading information to an insurance company for the purposes of defrauding the company. Penalties include imprisonment, fines, and denial of insurance benefits. If your University is located in Washington State, the definition of Spouse includes Washington State Registered Domestic Partner.

All refund requests must be sent to the University who will confirm nonstudent status with JCB, and submit the refund request on behalf of the student. The refund deadline is 25 days after the insurance term start date. Only refunds submitted by the University before the refund deadline will be considered. Credit card refunds must be requested within 120 days of the date of purchase and before the refund deadline. No refunds will be considered after the refund deadline. All refunds will incur a \$35 processing fee.

7. Create an account. Enter the email address you used on your UC San Diego Extended Studies application, and your student ID number (starting with “U”).
8. Follow all other prompts and submit. You will receive an update on your insurance waiver request within 5-7 business days.
